2. A valid and working email address—your own and not someone else's. If you don't have one, you can get a free one at www.hotmail.com or www.yahoo.com.
3. Completion of the AHA Core Instructor online course, if you are not currently an AHA instructor. You will receive a packet with the Core Instructor course manual and CD 2-4 weeks prior to the course. You must complete the course either with the enclosed DVD OR by logging onto the AHA instructor site and taking it there and **bring the certificate of completion to class.**
4. A letter recommending you as an instructor from your supervisor (see the 2nd page of this form). This can also be sent via fax to 544-0130 or email to robert.williams@stdavids.com **Prospective SDH instructors must be high performers with good interpersonal skills--teaching experience is preferred, but not required.**

The PALS Instructor Course is designed for health care professionals who are current proficient PALS Providers and have a firm working knowledge of the rationale and interventions in Pediatric Advanced Life Support. Instructor candidates will have completed the PALS Provider written exam with a score of $\geq 90\%$ and been identified as having instructor potential in a Provider Course. Airway, medication management, and rhythm interpretation skills are required. Resuscitation, critical care and teaching experiences are extremely helpful.
